Investigator Insight: After being stuck inside all winter, many people anxiously await the arrival of the warm spring weather – criminals included. Last week we noticed random acts of damage to property, yards and homes – and an increase in theft from vehicles. We want to remind everyone to be vigilant - if you see anything suspicious or odd please call 911. Be specific about what you are seeing with descriptions of vehicles and people. On vehicles, a license plate is always best but even the make, model, color and direction of travel is good. When describing people include the color of their clothing, hair, build type, and unique identifying characteristics. If vehicles are parked suspiciously in business lots after the business is closed – we would like to know that too. Please don't hesitate to call - when we partner together we become stronger.
