FRIDAY UPDATE: 04.09.16-04.15.16

Investigator Insight: This is the time of year we will start receiving reports of thefts from boats. Typically the boat is covered and pulled into a driveway - or along-side a garage - but valuables like depth finders, rods, underwater cameras, and trolling motors are left in the boats. These types of items fetch a nice price from pawn shops and online sale sites. If your boat is left outside – please remove these items from your boat. If you don't remove them, at least document the serial numbers so if they are stolen you can provide that information to the deputy.
