Investigator Insight: This time of year - and throughout the summer months - crimes of opportunity will increase. Anything left unattended in the yard, or in an open garage, may become an "opportunity" to someone passing by on foot, a bike, or in a car. Items like bikes, garden hoses, chainsaws, tools, boat motors, etc. are commonly stolen from yards.
