Investigator Insight: We have recently been dealing with daytime residential burglaries in our jurisdiction. Our office would really appreciate your help – we need you to call in any suspicious people or vehicles you are seeing in your neighborhood. Many of the cases we solve start with a call from a resident who calls 911 when they are observing something suspicious. When calling 911, a good description of the vehicle, the direction of travel, and a license plate if you can get it would be appreciated.
