**FRIDAY UPDATE: 06.25.16-07.01.16**

**Investigator Insight:** On July 5<sup>th</sup> we had two odd calls in Andover; I want to bring them to your attention for educational purposes. In both reports it appears that someone living at the house was having a small party. At some point, the party was posted on social media by someone – not the host. Within a short period of time there were 40-50 unknown people showing up to these gatherings and joining the party. Both hosts felt uncomfortable and called 911. Deputies arrived and assisted with clearing out the people. After the party-goers left, the hosts checked the homes and noticed things were stolen.

This is too coincidental to happen twice within a 24 hour period in Andover. It may be the start of a new trend where criminal groups and their "fringe" associates have discovered a new way to commit thefts or burglaries. Both of these incidents happened to young adults (18/19) who appear to be living at their family home and the owners were away. If this is a situation you could possibly find yourself in – talk to your family members, share this information – and if uninvited guests start showing up at your party, call 911 and let deputies help.
