Investigator Insight: Check out all the mail thefts from mailboxes in Oak Grove. Here are a few tips to prevent becoming a victim: Protect yourself by not mailing outgoing mail from an unsecured box and retrieve your mail as soon as possible after it is delivered. The thieves that are stealing your mail really want the routing numbers on checks they find, information about credit card accounts they can charge on, and personal information that may give them the ability to open accounts in your name. Anything you can do to prevent this from happening will be worth the effort.
