No incidents that would be reflected in this report were reported in Bethel this week

Investigator Insight: We have seen a recent increase if unforced entry garage burglaries; we have also come across of a lot of property we know is stolen but the property doesn't correspond with any recent burglary reports. Remember to document your serial numbers – it is more difficult for us to return property back to you without a serial number - and if we catch a criminal with a piece of property with your serial number on it, it is a much stronger case for us. Keep those garage doors shut and the service doors locked if you are not within sight of them. These burglaries are crimes of opportunity – and with a few easy steps taken by you, they can be prevented.
