Alert Neighbor: We want to give a shout-out to an alert neighbor in Ham Lake. He was biking by a home and saw a female entering a garage as he was passing by. The man had never seen the woman at the neighbor's house before – and he knows the owner of the home and the situation seemed odd. Instead of ignoring the situation, the man called 911 and reported what was happening. A deputy arrived in the area and located a suspicious vehicle and stopped it. The driver of the vehicle matched the description of the female that was seen at the home. She gave a false name to the deputy but the deputy figured out who she really was and she had warrants. After investigating, the female was arrested for Burglary, False Information, and Driving After Revocation. All because a neighbor was alert and called 911! Nice job 😊

DNA Identifies Thief: Last November there was a burglary at a business in Columbus; flat screen TV's had been stolen from multiple RV's at the location. While processing the scene, personal items possibly left behind by the suspect were collected and submitted to the Forensic Lab for DNA testing. A DNA profile was located in the system. The detective went to interview the suspect, who declined to speak with the Investigator, but he is being charged because of the DNA match.
