**FRIDAY UPDATE: 09.09.16 – 09.16.16**

This past week a resident alerted me to a scam that I had not seen. It happened via email and basically told you that you had won a lottery in Ghana and it provided you with a copy of your winning ticket. You were given the option of claiming the funds at the Guaranty Trust Bank in Ghana or you could provide the sender with a payment for \$280. The email goes on to state that once the \$280 is paid they will provide you with a Visa ATM card on which you can withdraw your funds. They also sent you the Visa card number, along with the expiration date, CVS code, and PIN number.

The email was poorly written but included a lot of pictures, step-by-step instructions, and graphics that could possibly add credibility to the scam. If you receive an email from Mrs. Claudia Borketey, the Managing Director & Remittance Manager from the bank of Guaranty Trust....it is a scam ☺
