ANDOVER AREA ARSON: UP TO \$5,000 REWARD FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO AN ARREST

In the past few weeks, there have been several arson fires set in Andover Public parks which has caused tens of thousands of dollars in damage. A reward of up to \$5,000 may be available for credible information leading to the arrest of the suspect(s) through the Minnesota IAAI Reward Project. A call to the MN Arson Tip Line and Reward application would be required. The Arson Hotline Number 1.800.723.2020.
