FRIDAY UPDATE: 10.09.15-10.16.15

I know we have been repeating ourselves about the IRS scam but it continues to victimize residents in our jurisdiction. There are many variations of the scam but here is the start of a conversation a resident heard this week before she hung up:

"We have been trying to reach you. The IRS is filing a lawsuit against you." They state they are from the IRS Department Number 31. The number that they called from is 314-449-9391. If you call it back, no one answers and there is no option to leave a voicemail.

If you receive this message – delete it - or if you receive this call – hang up. The IRS will not contact you in this manner.
