FRIDAY UPDATE: 11.11.16-11.18.16

We wanted to share with you a high-risk stop that was made last week. This situation rarely happens but it can – and it shows how important professionalism and cooperation is.

On routine patrol a deputy ran a license plate and it came back as a stolen vehicle. The deputy caught up to the vehicle and the driver pulled over before the deputy activated his emergency lights. Being the vehicle came back as stolen, the deputy made a high-risk traffic stop which means he approached the vehicle with his weapon drawn and waited for a partner to arrive and assist. The driver of the vehicle was cooperative and kept his hands in sight. Once the second deputy arrived the man was safely removed from the vehicle and put in handcuffs. While investigating on the scene, deputies learned the vehicle was not stolen and removed the man's handcuffs. A sergeant was called to the scene and the situation was explained. Deputies apologized to the driver and informed him he was free to leave. The driver showed no ill-will and stated the deputies were "just doing their jobs."
