**FRIDAY UPDATE: 12.02.16 – 12.09.16**

This week we had packages stolen from front steps and wallets stolen from shopping carts. We are unsure if you are aware but Amazon is now offering "Lockers" that your packages can be delivered to. I have seen them at Cub Foods locations around the cities. If you are ordering items from Amazon, consider having them shipped to a secured locker if you are not home during the day. As for wallets being stolen – if you insist on putting your purse in your cart, consider zipping it and using the straps that you use for securing children to secure your purse – and then put your coat over it. The extra steps you take to protect yourself will be worth it. Criminals are hanging out at stores this time of year to take advantage of any opportunity that is presented to them.
