AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CITY COUNCIL SALARIES
PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES

Recitals

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, Section 415.11 provides authority for the City Council to fix salaries of the mayor and council members by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish a reasonable salary for attendance at public meetings while members are conducting official business on behalf of the City or representing the City as liaison to other committees, commissions and units of government.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Columbus does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Annual Salaries. City Council salaries shall be set on an annual basis, as follows:


- (a) City Council Members: \$3,500 for regularly scheduled City Council and assigned committee meetings; \$40 per each additional meeting; and
- (b) Mayor: \$4,500 for regularly scheduled City Council and assigned committee meetings; \$40 per each additional meeting;

SECTION 2. Effective Date. The effective date of this ordinance shall be upon its passage and publication, according to law.


