RESOLUTION NO. 82-8  
OF THE TOWN BOARD  
OF THE TOWNSHIP OF COLUMBUS, ANOKA COUNTY, MINNESOTA,  
ADOPTING MINNESOTA STATUTES SECTION 272.162  
REGULATING THE SUBDIVISION OF LANDS

1. The Legislature of the State of Minnesota has enacted Minnesota Statutes Section 272.162 (1982 Minn. Sess. Law Serv., Chapter 564), restricting the transfer of subdivided parcels of land.
2. Minnesota Statutes Section 272.162, Subdivision 3, provides that if a municipality desires to be governed by the statute, a resolution stating the adoption of the statute must be filed with the county auditor.
3. The Town Board finds that this Resolution must also be filed with the County Recorder in order to provide notice to all land-owners within Columbus Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWNSHIP OF COLUMBUS, ANOKA COUNTY, MINNESOTA,

- a. That the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Section 272.162 (1982 Minn. Sess. Law Serv., Chapter 564) shall henceforth apply to property within the boundaries of Columbus Township.
- b. That a certified copy of this Resolution be filed with the Anoka County Auditor and with the Anoka County Recorder.
- c. That this Resolution shall be effective on the date on which it is filed with the Anoka County Auditor.
