**FRIDAY UPDATE: 08.17.18**

Here is a report I came across this week and I wanted to share it with you. Not everything deputies encounter is criminal in nature and sometimes people are just down on their luck. It is always encouraging when people "pay it forward" like Deputy Strecker did.

On 08/11/2018, while on routine patrol I observed a vehicle parked on the far west side of the business with the driver's side door open and a male's leg hanging out. I approached the vehicle and made contact with the male who was identified as xxxx who had been sleeping. xxxx admitted to arriving at the location sometime in the early morning. xxxx proceeded to tell me that he is now homeless after both of his parents had passed away. xxxx stated that he earns a little money here and there by giving private tennis lessons but it isn't a lot. xxxx admitted to being out of money and low on gas. xxxx also stated that he hasn't eaten since yesterday. xxxx did have a gallon of milk that he was drinking from. I talked with xxxx at length about getting some assistance from the county to help him get on his feet. xxxx stated that he has a degree from Gustavus College in Economics but hasn't been able to do anything with it. xxxx appeared to be too proud to seek assistance. xxxx was sober and didn't appear to be a user. xxxx just appeared to be down on his luck. I provided xxxx with \$20 to put some gas in his car and get something to eat. At that time xxxx asked me if he had to leave and I advised him that I wasn't going to kick him out, but the business may not appreciate it if he stays too long. I advised xxxx to call the Sheriff's Office if he decided that we could help him in any way. I then cleared the call and noticed that xxxx left the location prior to me leaving the area. No further action taken. Clear.
