Public Hearing – SKOOG’S OAK VIEW ESTATES PLAT 3 –
PRELIMINARY/FINAL PLAT (PC 18-114)
June 20, 2018

The June 20, 2018 Public Hearing to receive testimony regarding a request for a preliminary and final plat “Skoog’s Oak View Estates” creating three (3) new lots in the RR Rural Residential zoning district was called to order at 7:04 p.m. by Chair Garth Sternberg at the City Hall. Present were Commission members: James Watson, Pam Wolowski, Jesse Preiner, and Jody Krebs; City Administrator Elizabeth Mursko; City Planner Dean Johnson; and Recording Secretary Rochelle Busch.

Sternberg: Now were going to, were going to have a public hearing and discussion for Skoog’s Oak View Estates preliminary/final plat request page 1-16 and enclosures and a hand out. And at this time, I’d like to ask the recording secretary to read the notice as published.

Notice was read at this time by the recording secretary.

Sternberg: Thank you. And at this time, I’d like the applicants to please come forward.

Mursko: In your handout materials, you have the updated plat. Have a seat at the table.

Sternberg: Welcome. Hi, and if you could just state your name and address for the record.

Skoog R.: I’m Rodney Skoog, I live at 18366 Kettle River Blvd

Sternberg: Thank you Sir.

Skoog R.: Pardon

Sternberg: Thank you Sir.

Skoog R.: Oh

Skoog S.: I’m Sandra Skoog and I live at 18366 Kettle River Blvd

Skoog R.: For 58 years, no not quite

Sternberg: So, if you could just give us a little background on what it is your asking?

Skoog R.: Go ahead. She’s been working with them

Skoog S.: Basically, is Plat 3, it is a subdivision. And well technically its four lots because our home is on lot 4, and then we have 3 additional lots, on Kettle River Blvd that we are selling or will sell.

Mursko: The Skoog's are asking for both preliminary and final plat approval this evening.

Sternberg: Any questions? No questions, hearing none I'm going to open the hearing to the public. Any one from the public want to speak? Any one from the public? Ok, I'm going to close the hearing with the right to reopen.
