**FRIDAY UPDATE: 02.01.19**

**Investigator Insight:** We have seen a huge increase in vehicles being stolen while warming up. We know its cold but please do not leave your vehicles unattended. In the report we took last week, that we found funny, the vehicle wasn't stolen but easily could have been.

A deputy was called to Running Aces. An employee stated he had started his vehicle and left it parked in front of the entrance to warm up. When he returned to his vehicle, it was no longer running.

The deputy reviewed video footage and identified a female who had gotten in to the vehicle. He was able to locate the female and she said that she met two males - who were intoxicated - and she offered to give them a ride home. When they got outside, the intoxicated males stated the running vehicle was theirs. They all got into the vehicle and then something happened that lead the female to doubt they were the owners of the vehicle, so she shut off the car and got out. The deputy could not locate the intoxicated males, however, no real crime occurred.
