Investigator Insight: This last week there was mail stolen from Ham Lake, Columbus - with three more incidents occurring yesterday; these reports are not in our system yet but you will see them in our next Friday Update. Protect yourself by not mailing outgoing mail from an unsecured box and retrieve your mail as soon as possible after it is delivered. The thieves that are stealing your mail are looking for check routing numbers, information about credit card accounts they can charge on, and personal information that may give them the ability to open accounts in your name. Anything you can do to prevent this from happening will be worth the effort.
