**FRIDAY UPDATE: 02.15.19**

During this stretch of cold, and too much snow, we have seen some great things in our communities – neighbors and strangers coming together to help one another. Neighbors shoveling each other's driveways and walks, checking in on each other, picking up groceries for those who can't get out. It is great to see people helping others out. When reading the reports from Monday, February 11<sup>th</sup>, I noticed quite a few reports in that one day where I think deputies also went the extra mile and we wanted to share a few of them with you.

- A deputy received a call from an elderly woman who stated she was receiving numerous phone calls from telemarketers and wanted them to stop. The deputy visited with the woman and asked if she had family that could help her get on the "do-not-call list." She stated they were too busy to help so the deputy got her on the list.
- A deputy responded to a check-the-welfare call and found a male laying on the floor. The male advised he had been there for a couple hours. The deputy assisted the male to his mobility chair and then spoke to him about getting an emergency button for situations like this. The male was not quite hip to the idea, so the deputy located the nearest relative who was unaware and advised them of this concern. They worked together on a safety plan for the male.
- An off-duty deputy performed life-saving CPR on a male who went down at a gas station.
- Deputies were called - and then canceled - to a medical at a private residence of an elderly gentleman. After they were canceled they proceeded anyway. They found the male was injured from a fall he took after he got his vehicle stuck in a snowbank at the end of his driveway. The deputies provided medical care for his injuries and then pulled his vehicle out of the snowbank and parked it in the garage for him.
- A deputy responded to a CO Alarm that was going off. It was determined there was no CO emergency and that the battery was low. The deputy changed the battery for the homeowner.
