FRIDAY UPDATE: 03.01.19

This report was taken last week by one of our deputies. It is a perfect example of why we recommend that you always transfer the title at the DMV the same time you sell any type of motorized vehicle.

On 02-26-19 at 1840 hours, I made contact with the reporting party by phone regarding a civil dispute. The Reporting party reported that she recently traded a 1996 Chevrolet Camaro for a 1998 Honda Accord; the deal was made through an online website. Recently she was contacted by Blaine Police because the vehicle she traded was used in a crime; the vehicle is still registered to the reporting party. The reporting party also received a letter from Collins Brothers Towing indicating the vehicle has been impounded. The reporting party is concerned because the title was not properly transferred, is being used to commit crimes, and she may be liable for a tow bill that could result in a collections claim.
