FRIDAY UPDATE: 05.08.20

If you thought you were having a bad week, it may not be as bad as this woman's. Here is a summary of a report we took this week.

Deputies responded to a 911 hang-up call where someone stated there was a drunk female at the location and she needed to be removed - then they hung up. Apparently, the female was at a friend's house and started going "crazy" yelling and screaming. They locked her out of the home. She was beating on the door to get back in. A male exited the home and duck-taped her arms and legs to a chair in the front yard and called her ex-boyfriend to pick her up. Before deputies arrived, her ex-boyfriend had arrived and removed the duck-tape. No one at the scene was cooperative and the female would not provide a truthful story about what happened. She did not appear injured and refused help, so deputies cleared.
