**FRIDAY UPDATE: 05.22.20**

We are seeing fawns being born this time of year and I thought we would share the following information. Deer often deliver their newborns in strange places. Residents will find them and be concerned about a newborn fawn on their lawn, in their garden, on their driveway, etc. Most call because they think the fawn is in peril and mom is nowhere to be found; those who call ask what they should do for the fawn. The answer is to leave it alone, do not touch it, move it, or attempt to feed it. A healthy fawn will curl up, nap most of the day, and move their heads. They have no scent and predators cannot find them unless humans interfere. Mom leaves during the day for two primary reasons: to feed, and to keep her scent away from the fawn. Mom will come back, but don't expect her until dusk and certainly don't expect her if humans are hovering around. If you are fortunate enough to have the gift of a fawn, please enjoy the experience, respect Mother Nature and let the mom do what comes naturally. She will move the fawn daily so you may see it in different locations.

When the deputy made contact with them, they appeared malnourished with numerous scabs on their face. When speaking with them, paraphernalia and drugs were seen in the vehicle. A K9 was called to sniff the vehicle. Meth and Heroin were located, along with counterfeit money. Both were arrested.

05.19 Hwy 65/Crosstown Blvd NE – Warrant; a deputy was behind a vehicle in the drive-thru and recognized the driver as a male with a warrant. After getting his dilly bar, he stopped the vehicle. The male was formally identified and arrested.

Field sobriety tests were conducted and failed. After consulting an attorney, he refused the PBT. He was arrested.
