

**City of Columbus**  
**City Council Special Meeting**  
**June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017**

The June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017 special meeting of the City of Columbus City Council was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Dave Povolny at the City Hall. Present were Council Members Bill Krebs, Jeff Duraine, Denny Peterson; City Administrator Elizabeth Mursko, and Public Communications Coordinator Jessica Hughes.

Also present were: Joe Bazey, Pat Preiner, Jesse Preiner, and Mary Preiner.

**A. CALL TO ORDER – City Council Special Meeting – 7:00 p.m.**

**B. MOTION – Agenda Approval**

**Motion by Duraine to approve the agenda. Seconded by Peterson. Motion carried unanimously.**

**C. PUBLIC HEARING – Preiner Vacation of Ponding Drainage & Utility Easements**

At this time Mayor Povolny opened the hearing for the public to speak on the topic.

Hearing no one, Mayor Povolny closed the hearing.

City staff are recommending approval of Resolution 17-22, a resolution vacating of ponding & flowage, and a portion of a drainage and utility easement in the City of Columbus.

**Motion by Krebs (CC-17-102) to approve Resolution 17-22, a resolution (Preiner Family Addition Plat) vacating the ponding & flowage easement, and a portion of a drainage and utility easement in the City of Columbus. Seconded by Peterson. Motion carried unanimously.**

**D. PUBLIC HEARING – Vacation of a portion of Humber Street NE**

At this time Mayor Povolny opened the hearing for the public to speak on the topic.

Hearing no one, Mayor Povolny closed the hearing.

City Administrator Elizabeth Mursko explained that this project will be happening in phases; first was the CUP amendment that was approved at the June 28<sup>th</sup> City Council meeting, then the vacation of Humber Street NE, followed by the construction of a cul-de-sac, and Bazey (owner of Construction Technology Inc.) will do a land swap with the homeowner of another adjacent property to complete the Garage Solutions campus. Bazey explained that the three properties to the east of the Garage Solutions campus will gain access off of the cul-de-sac, and will be helpful in the possible scenario where Anoka County closes Lake Drive for construction. Bazey also said he will be building the cul-de-sac according to City dimension standards. Mursko commented that Bazey should get in touch with the City's Public Works Superintendent Jim Windingstad to discuss some concerns he has with grading the road prior to the installation of the cul-de-sac.

**Motion by Peterson (CC-17-103) to approve Resolution 17-23, a Resolution vacating a portion of Humber Street NE in the City of Columbus. Seconded by Duraine. Motion carried unanimously.**

**E. ADJOURNMENT**

**Motion by Krebs to adjourn. Seconded by Peterson. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 7:10 p.m.**
