**FRIDAY UPDATE: 06.07.19**

We wanted to share this with you. We found it funny; some things don't always go as planned.

Dispatched to the location for a public assist. The 15-year-old caller was requesting a ride home. Upon arriving I spoke with the caller who did not want his parents to know he was far from home and needed a ride home. I had the caller contact his parents who came and picked him up at the location. I waited at the location until the caller's parents arrived. No further action was taken.

On a more serious note – we had two reports this week both involving Sprint phone service.

I spoke with the victim regarding some suspicious phone calls. She advised last week she received a phone call from someone claiming to be from Sprint asking her if she had ordered two iPhones. She advised that after telling the person she had not, they stated that they did not think so because she lived in Minnesota and the phones were being shipped to New York. She advised that the person told her that they were having Fedex reroute the phones to her house. The victim was told once she received them, should then repackage the phones and send them back to Sprint with a separate self-addressed package they would send her.

The victim advised she thought this was suspicious, so she contacted Sprint, her cell phone provider. She learned that her Sprint account had been hacked and the previous phone calls were from someone trying to scam her. She advised that her account was not out any money and she had not lost any money.
