FRIDAY UPDATE: 06.14.19

Thefts from mailboxes increase this time of year. We want to remind you not to place outgoing mail in your mailbox – and to collect your mail as soon as possible after it is delivered.

CASE SUMMARY: Responded to a PC request from the victim. She advised that around the date of 6/6/19, she put a check in the mail made payable to MNSURE in the amount of \$61.00. On 6/7/19, person(s) unknown cashed the check in the amount of \$2,200. She did not know where the check was cashed. She said that the check was made payable to "Gabe L. Bailey." The account is from Well's Fargo. She reported it to Well's Fargo, who took a report, replaced the money into her account, and advised that they would investigate. They further advised that she report it to local law enforcement. The victim did not recognize the name and has no suspects. She said that she would try and find out where the check was cashed and forward that information to me.
