**ORIGINAL OFFICER NARRATIVE:** On 6/18/2020, at approximately 0225 hours, I was dispatched to the area for a report of a naked male who jumped out in front of the caller's vehicle. The caller stated the male looked to be on drugs because he was punching himself in the head. He was last seen walking north on Baugh St NW from 181st St NW. Deputies searched all side streets between 181st and Viking Blvd on Baugh St. Deputies also searched Burns Pkwy and neighborhoods branching off it. The male was not located.

The vehicle left but the victim was able to tell the deputy where it went. The vehicle and driver were located; the driver appeared impaired. He admitted to driving, being out with buddies, doing shots. He agreed to do the field sobriety tests, and told the deputy “they weren’t going to be good.” He was right. He was arrested and charges were elevated due to two prior DWI convictions.

### **Arrests & Incidents**

06.12 Lake George Park – Disturbing the Peace; multiple deputies responded to a large gathering of 250+ people at the park being disorderly. They were asked to leave the park, they refuse. A large group started to surround deputies, yelling "fxxx the police," "this is our park, we ain't leaving," "ACAB," "justice for George Floyd," "hands up, don't shoot," "fxxx 12." Extra law enforcement was called in. Smoke canisters were deployed, and some people left. For those who didn't leave, tear gas was deployed. Medical aid was provided to those who had negative reactions to the smoke and tear gas.

06.14 St Francis Blvd/217 Ave NW – 3<sup>rd</sup> degree DWI; a deputy responded to a call of a vehicle in the ditch. When he made contact with the driver, he appeared impaired; he told the deputy he had one beer. Field sobriety tests were conducted and failed. He was arrested. .16

06.16 221 Ave/Lake George Blvd – Careless Driving; a deputy responded to a 2-car crash. One of the driver's was found to be inattentive to his driving and he struck a vehicle at a stop sign. The driver was issued a citation.
