FRIDAY UPDATE: 06.21.19

There were so many reports of fraud this week: Microsoft, Direct TV, someone posing as a Ramsey Police Officer, someone posing as an Anoka County Investigator. It is crazy. Unfortunately, our advice is to trust no-one and verify everything.

On a lighter note, check out the report below. It isn't always *"lights and sirens"* – more often it is about just helping people - and sometimes their cat.

I was dispatched to the location for a report of a cat stuck in a recliner.

Upon arrival, I made contact with the owner who advised me that her cat, Max, was stuck under the couch which has an electronic recliner. I noticed that the tail of the cat was twisted in a spring under the couch and it appeared I would injure the cat unless I took the couch apart. I disassembled the couch to access the animal. I was missing some tools, so I requested the fire department to assist in either cutting the couch or taking the mechanical device off.

With the assistance of the fire department, we freed the cat from the recliner. We put the couch back together and tried our best to minimize any damage to the couch and animal.
