FRIDAY UPDATE: 08.02.19

We couldn't decide between telling you about all the loose cows roaming around in Oak Grove, or a great officer discretion story – we landed on officer discretion. Sometimes, there is a situation where mis-communication occurs and deputies are always encouraged to use their best judgement. Here is the report.

On 07/30/2019 I was patrolling and witnessed a vehicle parked on the side of the road and ran the license plate; it showed that the registered owner had an active misdemeanor warrant out of Anoka County. The warrant was issued in September 2018 for failure to appear.

I went to attempt a warrant arrest at the home. The suspect came to the door without issue and I advised her of the warrant. She appeared very confused and stated she had no idea why the warrant was issued. I advised that the warrant showed a bail amount of \$200.00 which she stated she would be able to pay. The warrant was confirmed, and she was taken into custody without issue.

Due to the nature of the warrant, the issue date, the suspects age, and the bail amount, I chose to transport her to the Warrants window at the Anoka County Jail instead. She paid her bail without incident and her husband arrived shortly after to bring her home.
