FRIDAY UPDATE: 08.03.17

We've seen this before but through it was worth another mention. Someone's home was put on Craigslist "for rent."

On 8/2/18 at 1648, I was dispatched a phone call regarding a fraudulent craigslist ad.

I called and spoke with the victim who reported someone had posted ads on craigslist offering to rent out the home for \$850/month. I located two ads on craigslist with the following Post Id's: 6659210xxx and 6659211xxx.

The victim said that he had some people walking around his home without notice. He advised the home was for sale, but the ads on craigslist were fake. I advised him to report the ads through craigslist and have them removed. The only information he had was the person that placed the ads referred to himself as reverend.

There were no reported victims of the craigslist postings at the time of this report. The victim was provided with a case number.
