FRIDAY UPDATE: 08.09.19

Last Sunday in Oak Grove, a resident reported some suspicious activity and we wanted to share it with you. The woman was working in her yard and she was approached by an unknown male who wanted to talk to her about her fence line. She stated the male kept trying to get her to walk towards the back of her property. The female believes that while she was talking to the male, an accomplice of his entered her home because when she went back in, she noticed that inside her drawers, everything was in complete disarray, and items had been moved. She did not believe anything was stolen, just rummaged through.

Kind of an odd report. If you are approached by someone in your yard, make sure you are where you can see any unlocked entry points to your home. If the person makes you feel uncomfortable, ask them to leave. If they don't leave, call 911.
