FRIDAY UPDATE: 08.10.18

I wanted to mention this report because this is something I often do without thinking when stopping to get gas. Also, even when pumping gas, either lock the doors or keep an eye on your vehicle. In the past we have had reports of purses being stolen from passenger side vehicle seats.

I was dispatched to the above address for a theft from vehicle. I spoke with the victim and he advised that an unknown female took his iPhone 9+ from his truck MN plate xxUxx4 as he parked in the parking lot of the gas station and went into grab a pop. The victim stated that he already had sat down with the manager and looked at the video and he stated all you could see was a female and you could not make out the vehicle plate.

I went in and watched the video and the plate on the car was not visible. It appeared that the female was waiting in the parking lot for someone to park and then go into the store, then she walked up to the vehicle and looked in saw the phone and then grabbed it and left. The victim stated his phone was locked and that there would not be away for her to get in. The victim stated he just want to make the report and talk to the employees to see if they knew who she was. The video was really hard to see the face on the female and the manager stated that they would show it to the night employees and see if they know who it is and they would call if they had any information.
