**FRIDAY UPDATE: 08.30.19**

We know we have great residents, but there are a few we want to give a special shout out to this week! Having people who are willing to act in an emergency, or notice when their help is needed, is truly a blessing to our community.

On Thursday a woman was driving and noticed an older male walking and he appeared to be confused. She stopped and spoke to the male and realized he didn't know where he was. She brought him to our office to get help. He was identified and it was discovered that he had recently moved to a senior living facility and had gotten turned around and couldn't find his way home. Deputies contacted his son, who arrived and transported him home.

Last Friday, we were called to a water rescue after a boat had capsized and there was a male calling for help. Before deputies arrived, two residents noticed the male in duress and they grabbed a row boat and were preparing for a rescue. Deputies arrived before they attempted it, but with the boat all ready to go, it greatly increased the response time and allowed deputies to get to the man faster.
