FRIDAY UPDATE: 08.31.18

This week our office received multiple reports from residents in different cities about "roofing companies" harassing them. One company claimed to get the resident's information from the city - who supposedly said that she needed a new roof - and the company told her they would be out that day at 11 am to inspect it. Another resident reported that a roofing company contacted him and wanted to inspect his roof and when he said no, they began leaving him threats on his voicemail. Yet another company requested to come out and inspect a roof in Linwood - the resident said no, she wasn't interested - and the company stated they would be out anyway to do an inspection. All the residents were advised to call 911 if anyone did show up. There was no financial loss in these incidents, but due to the number of calls reported in a short period of time, we wanted to bring this situation to your attention.
