**FRIDAY UPDATE: 09.04.20**

This week there was a report where a woman received a voicemail that stated, "hey dude, you need to call me back, if they find the bodies we are in deep sh\*\*." When the deputy called the number, he reached a 12 year-old-girl who admitted to making the prank call on a dare and apologized. The deputy then called the victim to share what he discovered and passed along the girl's apology.

The victim "still had her doubts about me being a Deputy with the Anoka County Sheriff's Office. I provided her my name, the case number and the phone number to dispatch, to confirm my identity. She called dispatch and still had her doubts about my identity. She had another person call dispatch and confirm my identity, and he called her back after I left him a voicemail. I advised her where she could pick up a copy of the report to further confirm the accuracy of my information."

08.28 137xx Round Lake Blvd NW – Criminal Vehicular Operation; deputies responded to a five-vehicle crash; one vehicle basically plowed into four stopped vehicles. The driver of the rouge vehicle appeared impaired, with slow and sluggish physical response; he also stated he had used narcotics. A

warrant for his blood was obtained and the vehicle was searched. Drugs, paraphernalia, and a loaded gun was located. Blood was drawn and he was taken to jail.

09.02 23xx Bunker Lake Blvd NW – 3<sup>rd</sup> degree DWI; a deputy was dispatched to a crash; Sirius called 911 to report airbags in a vehicle had been deployed. When he arrived he located a crash.
