**FRIDAY UPDATE: 09.06.19**

Deputies encounter a variety of people throughout their work day. Some are having a good day, some are not. Some are dealing with mental health or addiction issues, some just want to be left alone. Sometimes all they can do is offer their assistance, or their shoes:

Dispatched to check the welfare of a male walking on the shoulder of Viking. I arrived and spoke with the male who was shirtless and had no shoes. He said he was fine and was walking from North Branch to Coon Rapids where he had a camp site in Bunker Park. I offered him a ride and he refused. He did not appear to be intoxicated or have any immediate health concerns. He did ask for a pair of shoes. I gave a pair of old boots from my squad since we wore the same size. Clear.

#### **Thefts & Damage to Property**

- 08.31 144xx Bluebird St NW – damage to mailbox; hit by a vehicle
