Calls are not always as they appear. Here is an example of what a deputy thinks he or she is responding to, and what they are actually responding to. We were very thankful the dispatched call was incorrect in this case!

### **ORIGINAL OFFICER NARRATIVE**

Deputies dispatched to the area of 170th Ave and 3rd St NE in Ham Lake on a PI (personal injury) accident involving a vehicle that hit a child getting off the school bus. Deputies arrived on scene and learned the child was not hit by a vehicle.

I spoke to the child's mother who said her son got off the school bus across the street and was running towards her and hit his head on the mailbox. She said he has a shiner on his left eye, but didn't need medical attention.

We cleared with NFA.
