Investigator Insight: Easy tips prevent thefts. This last week we noticed a lot of thefts from unsecure garages and vehicles. Did you close your garage door? Is your car locked? Did you remember to bring in your laptop/tablet/wallet/keys? Here is your reminder to double check! Make it part of your nightly routine. Simple things like this can prevent thefts.
