### **Scams**

10.03 Spoke to the 18 yo male victim regarding a scam report. He stated he began speaking to a person on Instagram who had the username brandyylisa33@gmail.com. He sent the person nude photos of himself and now the person is demanding money or they will send the photos to his friends. He was advised to report the user to Instagram and block the accounts.

#### **Thefts & Damage to Property**

10.04 14xx 154 Lane NW – overnight ding-dong-ditch; suspect identified

### **Arrests**

09.29 137xx Underclift St NW – DWI 3<sup>rd</sup> degree; deputies responded to a crash where one person hit a parked vehicle. The driver who hit the parked car appeared impaired. Field sobriety tests were conducted and failed. He blew .00 so a warrant for blood was obtained. He was arrested.
