FRIDAY UPDATE: 10.25.19

We had three reports involving Verizon this week where phones were fraudulently ordered on accounts and are being shipped to the account holder. It is odd, and it is not clear how the thieves obtained this information. All three victims were elderly. Here is one report:

Reporting party (RP) reported that her mother had her Verizon account hacked into. She reported that her mom received a phone call from people claiming to be Verizon representatives, and gave them some personal information. She reported that she then found out two phones had been ordered to her house. She called Verizon and found out this was a scam. They refunded her money. RP reports that the scammers told her mom they would be coming to her house on 10-23-19 at 1000 to pick up the ordered phones. RP requested extra patrol of the victim's house around this time. I forwarded this information to the dayshift squad. I also advised RP to have her Mom call 911 if she sees anyone suspicious.
