**FRIDAY UPDATE: 11.02.18**

**Investigator Insight:** This last week there was a burglary at an Andover residence. The burglar gained access to the home by going into an unlocked vehicle in the driveway. The garage door opener was used to open the garage, then enter the home through the unlocked house door. This type of burglary is easily preventable by locking vehicle doors, removing/hiding garage door openers, and locking your house. Do these things to prevent this from happening to you.
