The holiday season is here! Hopefully you have started your shopping but we want to remind you of a few things you can do to protect yourself when you are out-and-about.

- Do not leave your purse in a shopping cart – often thieves reach in, steal your wallet and are long gone before you know your wallet was stolen.
- Park in a well-lit area and know what is going on around you. Do not leave your purse in the cart while loading your purchases in to your car.
- If you have a trunk – use it to keep your packages out-of-site. If you don't, figure out a way to conceal your treasures when going from store to store.
- Only bring the credit cards you are going to use while shopping. Consider using **only** credit cards and not your debit card when shopping. That way if you are a victim of theft or a data breach thieves cannot access the money in your checking account.
