We have started to see a few reports in Anoka County of packages being stolen from the front step. As the holiday season approaches and online shopping popularity continues to grow, consider delivering your package to:

- A local relative or trusted neighbor who will be home to pick it up when it arrives.
- Your office where there's someone to accept delivery.
- A P.O. box or UPS mailbox; be aware that these have a monthly rental cost and not all PO boxes will accept packages — find out before you rent!
- Search for a locker location near you on [Amazon's Locker page](#) or when selecting shipping options at checkout.
- Opt for in-store pickup.
