An Oak Grove deputy has taken a couple reports regarding scammers posing as Connexus Energy - he asked us to pass the information along:

I read about a new scam this week that was affecting the east coast and it has hit MN now. I took a scammer phone call report in which they pose as Connexus Energy and say that you are behind on your bill. Then they want you to buy gift cards to pay them money or they will "shut your power off." They even have their phone number rigged to make you think you are calling Connexus. The number is 1-800-549-9604 and push option 2. Please pass this on to your online followers.
