**FRIDAY UPDATE: 12.06.19**

We have seen an increase in calls like the one below; please spread the word about this scam.

I was dispatched a phone call report. The reporting party received a phone call at 13:30 hours from a male who identified himself as Ron Martin. He reported to be from an unknown law enforcement agency. The call appeared to come from phone #609-488-4528. The man stated there were arrest warrants issued against the reporting party for an alleged crime that had been committed on the southern US border.

The man had the reporting party's correct SSN. The reporting party told the caller that it was the correct number. The man said someone was coming to arrest her tomorrow. I advised the reporting party to immediately call 911 if an unknown person showed up at her residence. I suggested she monitor her credit reports for any new unknown accounts and think about putting a fraud alert on them. I further advised the reporting party that she should hang up on anyone asking for personal information. I provided her with the case number to assist in filing a fraud report with the credit bureaus.
