This report was taken by one of our deputies this last week. Please don't give out any personal information over the phone and if it doesn't feel right, it probably isn't.

### **ORIGINAL OFFICER NARRATIVE**

I was dispatched a phone call report regarding suspicious activity.

I spoke with the caller, who advised me that last Wednesday, he received a phone call from Fed Ex asking when he was going to be home. The caller advised me that it was an automated system and stated he needed to sign for a package that was being delivered to his residence. The caller advised me that he did not order anything offline lately and was not expecting any packages. The caller explained that he did not give out any personal information and did not respond to the phone call. The caller advised me that he received a package from Fed Ex yesterday (12/15) and it was a Verizon cell phone with no return address on it. The caller advised me that he never ordered a cell phone and was not a Verizon customer.

The caller explained that he contacted all of his credit card companies and had alerts put out on them. He told me that nothing new has been opened and that he also talked with Verizon, who told him that they have none of his personal information.

I advised the caller too contact us if anything else suspicious occurred.
