FRIDAY UPDATE: 12.27.19

This week we saw an increase in forced entry thefts from vehicles. Basically, the thief saw a backpack, wallet, or purse in a vehicle, and they decided it was worth breaking a window to get it. Remember to always keep valuables out of sight – or better yet, don't leave anything of value in your vehicle.
