**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6 OF THE
CITY OF COLUMBUS CODE OF ORDINANCES**

The City Council of the City of Columbus ordains the following:

SECTION I. Chapter 6 of the Columbus City Code is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 6-100.

C. **COMMERCIAL VEHICLE RESTRICTIONS.** No person shall operate any commercial truck, or commercial vehicle, on the following roads in the City of Columbus:

1. Howard Lake Drive between Kettle River Boulevard and the easterly City Boundary
2. Zurich Street/Running Aces Boulevard/147th Avenue Northeast between Lake Drive Northeast (CSAH 23) and West Freeway Drive (CSAH 54)
3. Notre Dame Street NE from West Broadway Ave. (CSAH 18) to 181st Avenue NE.
4. 181st Avenue NE from West Broadway Ave. (CSAH 18) to Kettle River Blvd (CSAH 62).


Said restrictions shall not apply to municipal vehicles, public safety vehicles, garbage or recycling vehicles while on their collection routes, school buses, or deliveries or services to a residential or business address accessed from the posted road.

SECTION II. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance was adopted by the Columbus City Council on this 11th day of September, 2019 and shall become effective after its publication.


