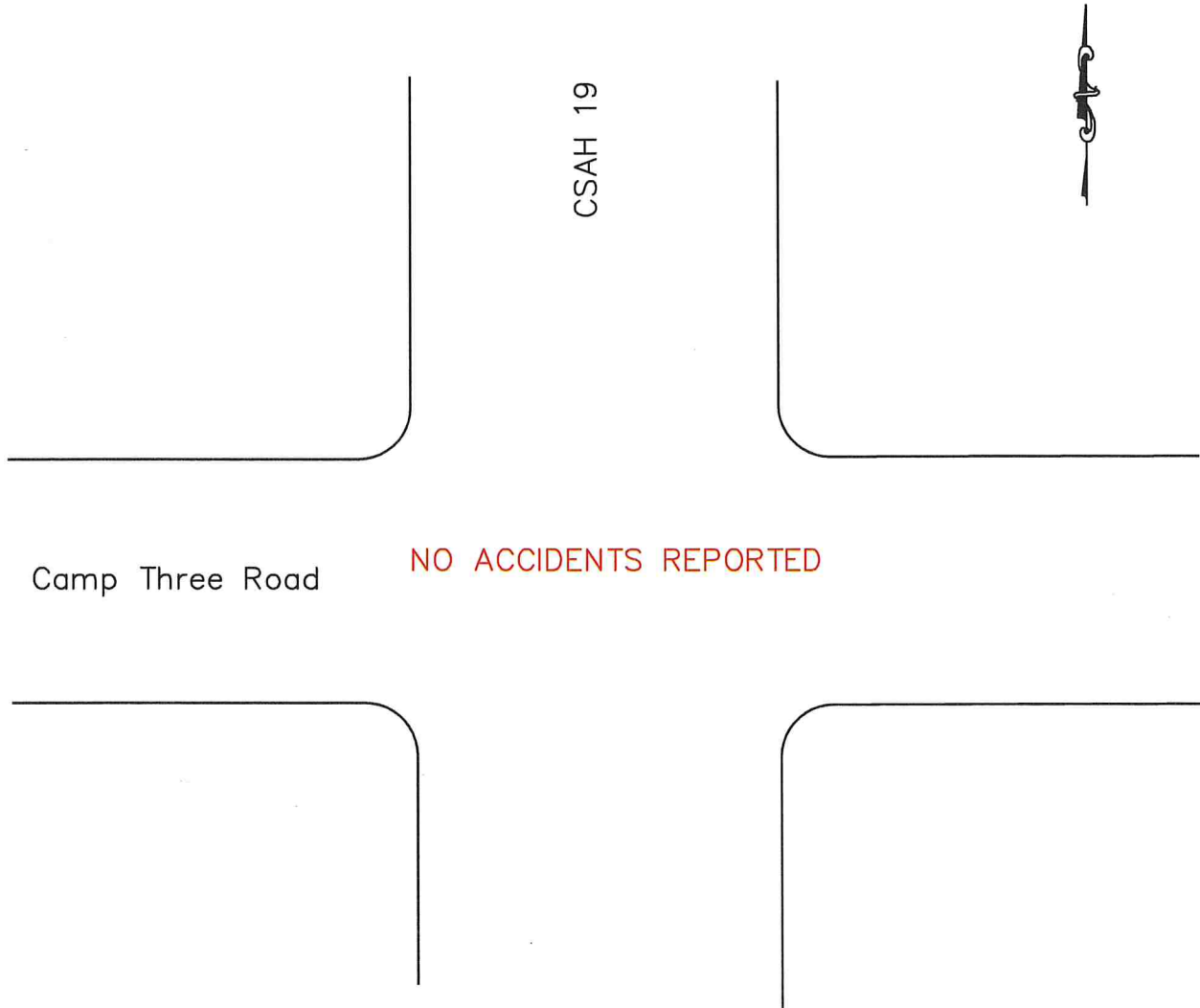


ANOKA COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT COLLISION DIAGRAM

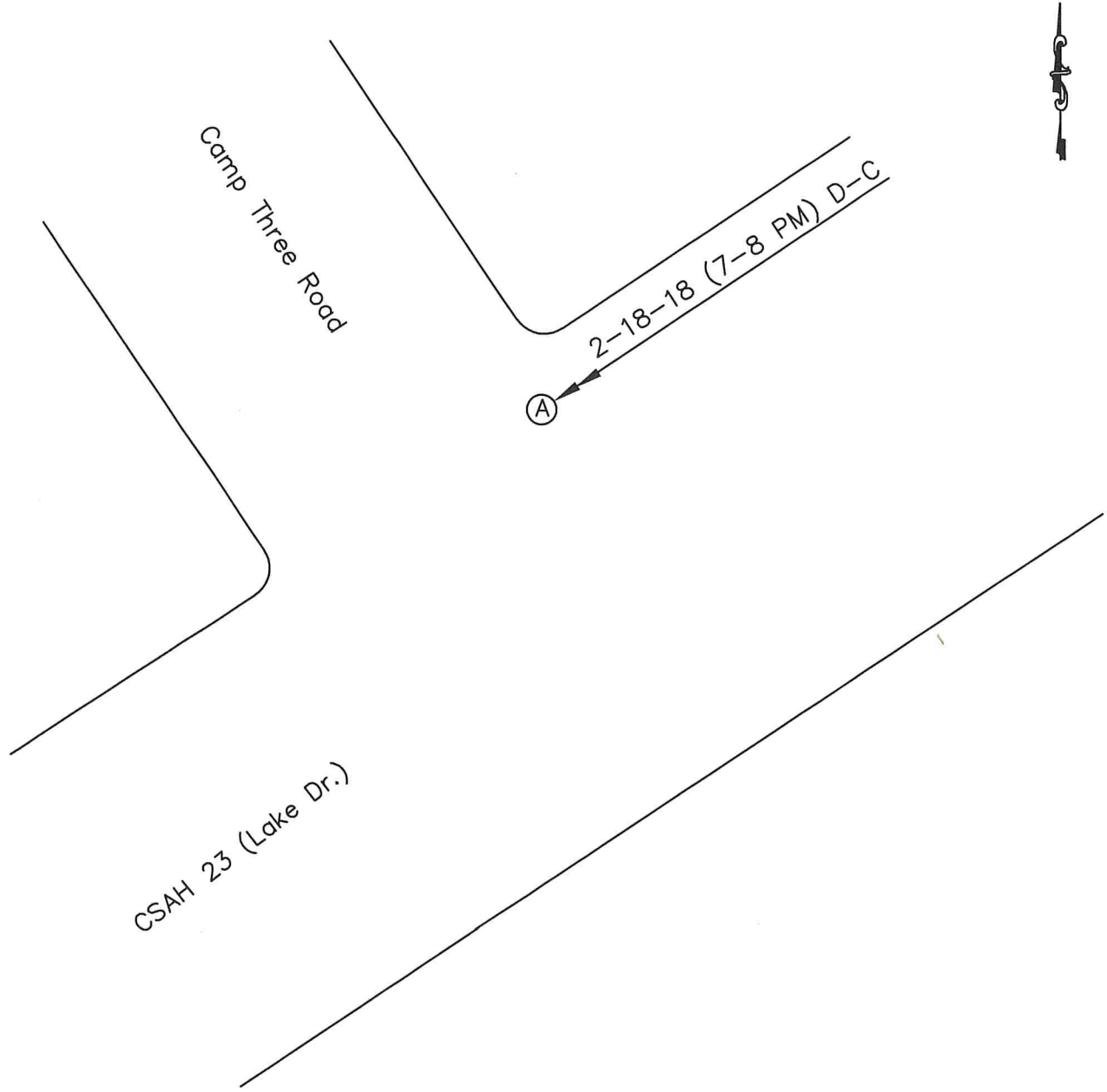

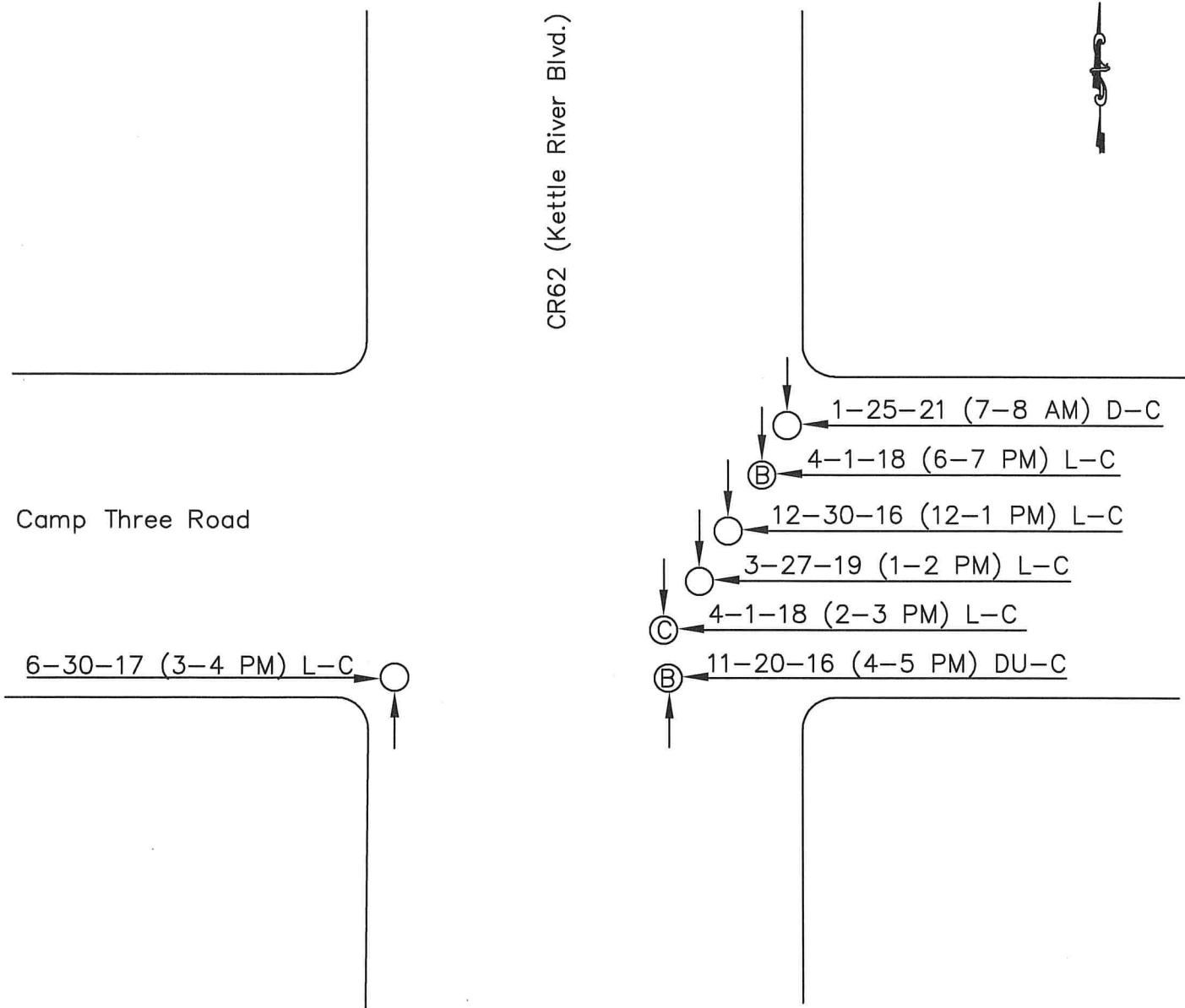

4 Personnel Committee Report for August 11, 2021 Council Meeting

Senior/Community Center Opening

The Columbus Lions and Senior group inquired about regaining use of the city's Senior/Community Center, beginning in September. The Lions would like to reinstate their monthly pancake breakfasts and the Senior group is interested in reestablishing their weekly meetings/lunches.

The Personnel Committee, consisting of Mayor Preiner, Elizabeth Mursko and Janet Hegland, met on August 3, 2021 to discuss this request. With the Delta variant surging in various parts of the country and state and with infection, hospitalization and death rates increasing, we referenced the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) updated COVID-19 Guidelines for Festivals, Fairs and large gatherings (as of 6.30.21) and the CDC guidance for organizing large events and gatherings (updated 5.20.21), and the latest COVID vaccination statistics (for Anoka County, 64.2% of the total population have completed the complete series of Covid vaccine).

Based on these recommendations the key take away points were:

- Avoid large events and gatherings when possible. Large gatherings are defined by CDC as gatherings that bring together many people from multiple households in a private or public space.
- Consider level of risk when deciding to host an event
- Promote healthy behaviors and maintain healthy environment to reduce risk when large events and gatherings are held
- Be prepared if someone gets sick during or after the event.

Should the city consider allowing use of its senior/community center for these requested uses, or other uses as may come forth from the community, the following are examples (not a complete list) of policies/procedures it would need to define.

- Reduced capacity protocols to allow for distancing, including appropriate layouts of tables/chairs
- Protocols for staging arrivals to limit congregation of people waiting (e.g., staged arrival times, reservations)
- Limit the time people are seated in the center
- Institute protocols for disinfection between groups
- Require use of single serving condiments, disposable dishware/flatware,
- Protocols for the required contact tracing
- Define mask policy since participants would include the vaccinated and unvaccinated public
- Determine need for physical barriers/sneeze guards for ticket areas, food prep area, etc.
- Establish walkway flow plan
- Determine whether professional cleaning service would be required and determine tiers of service and costs
- Finalize fee structure to consider these additional administrative burdens on the city

It is the recommendation of the Personnel Committee to defer opening the Columbus Senior/Community to the public for event gatherings until January 2022, contingent on status of the pandemic and guidance from MDH and CDC. Please note, this would not impact our decision to allow the public back in the chambers or the Senior/Community Center for Planning Commission/Council meetings or neighborhood meetings, since the above criteria have already been defined and food/beverages are not being served.

Requested Action

The Personnel Committee is seeking approval from the Council to defer opening the Columbus Senior/Community to the public for event gatherings until January 2022, contingent on status of the pandemic and guidance from MDH and CDC.
