RESIDENTIAL DOG KENNEL INTERIM USE PERMIT – 5551 PINE ST NE – EDWARD LAUDERBAUGH  
1-18-2023**

The 1-18-2023 Public Hearing to consider a request for a residential dog kennel Interim Use Permit by Edward Lauderbaugh at 5551 Pine St. NE was called to order by Chair Rob Hanegraaf at the City Hall at 6:06 PM. Present were Planning Commission members Ron Hanegraaf, Barb Bobick, Frank Ramisch, and Bethany Barrette, City Administrator Elizabeth Mursko, Planning and Zoning Permit Tech Ella Giefer, and Associate Planner Frank Koenen.

In attendance via interactive technology were Sue Wagamon and an unidentified phone number.

Also, in attendance in person were Kyle Lauderbaugh, Ed Lauderbaugh, Janet Hegland, Jesse Preiner, Myron Angel, and Cindy Angel.

The meeting was held in an interactive technology meeting format.

**Hanegraaf:** And we'll go on to item number 7, which is a public hearing. And this is 5551 Pine St. NE Kennel Interim Use Permit, Edward Lauderbaugh, pages 1-23. Ella would you read the notice as published in the Forest Lake Times?

Notice was read at this time by the recording secretary.

**Hanegraaf:** Thank you Ella. Since we have the applicant already sitting here up front. Kyle Lauderbaugh, since you're speaking for your father tonight, could you give your name and your address and your father's name and address?

**Kyle Lauderbaugh:** I'm Kyle Lauderbaugh, I live 7750 Silver Lake Rd. in Mounds View, but my dad lives 551 Pine St. Edward Lauderbaugh.

**Hanegraaf:** OK, thank you. As is normal protocol, we usually ask you to give a brief description of what your application is about, but since Ed you've been through this couple of times, you can give a short brief for what you want to do.

**Kyle Lauderbaugh:** Well I love I love dogs, having them around and having them with me. It's nice to have companions. He likes to go up north and take the dogs with and have them around just to be safe because he can't hear so they help him help him in that way too.

**Hanegraaf:** OK. You got a dog that's pregnant?

**Kyle Lauderbaugh:** Yeah, one dog that's pregnant.

**Hanegraaf:** OK, so you don't have many puppies there are?

**Kyle Lauderbaugh:** Four.

**Hanegraaf:** Four puppies, they're not born yet though?

**Kyle Lauderbaugh:** Oh she gave birth.

**Hanegraaf:** Oh she did. OK and you don't plan to keep them?

**Kyle Lauderbaugh:** No, give them away. He wants them to have a good home. Once they're 8 weeks of age then he plans on giving them away.

**Hanegraaf:** Can you pull the microphone just a little closer to you, Kyle? Thank you.

**Kyle Lauderbaugh:** Once they're eight weeks of age, then he plans on giving them away to a good home.

**Hanegraaf:** So then he'll be down to five dogs?

**Kyle Lauderbaugh:** No, he has six. He's gonna keep the mother. Just the babies he's going to give away to a good home.

**Hanegraaf:** OK, all right. Anybody have any questions?

**Ramisch:** No, this seems like just the renewal and he hasn't had any problems with it, so on my part there should be no question.

**Bobick:** I did have a question on page 10 and 12. The weights of the dogs on those two pages aren't listed. Is that something we need to know? We should probably know approximately how big they are, right?

**Mursko:** I would ask the question of the applicant. It's not required by the zoning code, but again they submitted their rabies certificate, so I think it's a fair question.

**Bobick:** Do you know how much Cinnamon weighs about?

**Kyle Lauderbaugh:** I'd say 55 pounds.

**Bobick:** Okeydoke. The other one is Queen 2?

**Kyle Lauderbaugh:** 48 pounds.

**Bobick:** OK, cool thank you.

**Hanegraaf:** Any other questions? Having no other questions, we're going to open up the public hearing tonight if there's anyone who has any interest in this manner and wants to present testimony as evidence on this issue, please acknowledge themselves by stating their name and address will go with anybody who's in the building first. Hearing nobody come forth, we'll ask if there's anybody on Zoom who would like to present testimony tonight. Hearing none, we'll close the public hearing.

At this time Chair Hanegraaf closed the public hearing. Hearing closed at 6:10 PM.
